


PARTS LIST:

1	Passenger Sidebar	4	1/2 x 1-1/2" OD x 1/8" Flat Washers
1	Driver Sidebar	6	10mm Clip Nuts
2	Driver Side Front/Passenger Side Rear Mounting Brackets	14	10-1.50mm x 40mm Hex Head Bolts
2	Driver Side Rear/Passenger Side Front Mounting Brackets	22	10mm x 27mm OD x 3mm Flat Washers
4	1/2" x 2" Hex Bolts	14	10mm Lock Washers
4	1/2" Lock Washers	8	10mm Hex Nuts



PROCEDURE:

- 1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.
- 2. Locate the driver side front mounting location under the vehicle on the pinch weld, (Figure 1).
- 3. Install the 10mm Clip Nut. **NOTE**: The front mount requires only (1) Clip Nut, **(Figure 1)**, while the rear mount will require (2) Clip Nuts, **(Figure 3)**.
- **4.** Loosely attach the driver side front Mounting Bracket to the pinch weld using the included (2) 10mm x 40mm Hex Bolts, (2) 10mm Lock Washers, (4) 10mm Flat Washers and (2) 10mm Hex Nuts, **(Figure 2 & 4)**. Do not tighten hardware at this time.
- 5. Attach the top of the Mounting Bracket to the previously installed Clip Nut with (1) 10mm x 40mm Hex Bolt, (1) 10mm Lock Washer and (1) 10mm Flat Washer, (Figure 2). Repeat Steps 2 5 for driver side rear Mounting Bracket installation. NOTE: Rear Mounting Brackets require (2) Clip Nuts, (2) 10mm x 40mm Hex Bolts, (2) 10mm Lock Washers and (2) 10mm Flat Washers to attach the top of the Mounting Bracket to the inner body panel, (Figure 3 & 4). Snug but do not tighten hardware.
- 6. With assistance, carefully place the Sidebar into position and attach it to the Mounting Brackets using the included (2) 1/2" x 2" Hex Bolts, (2) 1/2" Lock Washers and (2) 1/2" Flat Washers, (Figure 4). NOTE: If properly installed, the Side Bar mounting slot on the Mounting Brackets will be vertical, (Figure 2 & 4).
- 7. Level and align the Sidebar with the side of the vehicle then tighten all hardware.
- 8. Repeat steps 2 to 7 for passenger side Mounting Bracket and Sidebar installation.
- **9.** Periodically check and retighten the hardware as necessary.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

For stainless steel: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Sidebar.

For gloss black finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Sidebar.
